13 **WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs has launched "*Breaking***
14 ***The Cycle*" an unprecedented \$20 million for innovations designed to help low-lying**
15 **communities identify areas that are continuously devastated during disasters; and**

16 **WHEREAS, as part of the "*Breaking The Cycle*" Program, the Department of**
17 **Community Affairs is urging county and city governments to prepare, adopt, and implement**
18 **Local Mitigation Strategies through the use of interlocal or joint powers agreements; and**

20 **WHEREAS, Local Mitigation Strategies create and implement programs,**
21 **accelerates post-disaster recover, saves money, and is otherwise in the best interest of the**

1 public's health safety, and welfare.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
3 OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, THAT:

4 Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and hereby
5 ratified and confirmed by the City Commission.

6 Section 2. The Mayor and City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines,
7 Florida, hereby express their support of the Department of Community Affairs "*Breaking*
8 *The Cycle*" Program and express willingness to enter into an interlocal or joint powers
9 agreement with Broward County, the terms and conditions of which will be negotiated in
10 good faith, so as to mutually undertake efforts to create and implement Local Mitigation
11 Strategies.

12 Section 3. The site located at the Southwest corner of 196 Avenue and
13 Sheridan Street is designated as a natural reservation on the City of Pembroke Pines Urban
14 Greenways and Natural Reserve Map adopted in its Recreation and Open Space Element of
15 the City's Comprehensive Plan and is a priority for implementing the City's local mitigation
16 strategies. The City shall continue to proceed to change the Future Land Use designation of
17 the site from Estate to Conservation.

19 Section 4. The City clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this

2 Section 5. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby
3 repealed to the extent of such conflict.

4 Section 6. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is
5 held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or
6 application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this
7 Resolution.

8 Section 7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage
9 and adoption.
