A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF

PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, SUBMITTING TO REFERENDUM A **QUESTION TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF** PEMBROKE PINES AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$250,000,000) AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT (WITHOUT REGARD TO ORIGINAL ISSUE DISCOUNT OR PREMIUM) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES, FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF THE BOND REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER AND CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AND CHAPTER 100, FLORIDA STATUTES,

AS AMENDED; PROVIDING FOR THE PLACE AND PLACES WHERE THE BOND REFERENDUM ELECTION IS TO BE HELD; PROVIDING FOR

AUTHORIZATION AND DIRECTION TO THE CITY CLERK TO PERFORM CERTAIN DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS

RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida (the "City") has determined: 1) a police

station and public safety complex are needed for public safety reasons; 2) that there are several

streets and roadways within the City that require immediate repair and improvement; 3) that

there is a need to design, construct, repair or improve several City Parks and Recreational

Facilities; 4) that there is a need to design, construct, repair and improve the Plaza at Charles F.

Dodge City Center and acquire art for public spaces city-wide; and 5) that there is a need to

acquire land for future parks facilities and affordable housing projects; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of the City (the "City Commission") finds

that it is necessary and desirable to construct and equip public safety facilities, new community

1	facilities,	recreation	facility	improvements,	roadway	and	infrastructure	improvements,	and
2	acquisitio	on of land fo	or capita	l improvements	(collective	ly, th	e "Projects"); ar	nd	

- WHEREAS, it is a municipal and public purpose to pay the cost of the Projects through
- 4 the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City, payable from ad valorem taxes, as
- 5 hereinafter provided, to serve the health, safety, and welfare of all the citizens and residents of
- 6 Pembroke Pines, Florida; and
- WHEREAS, the City Commission hereby determines that it serves a paramount public
- 8 purpose that the Projects be constructed, renovated and replaced and that it is in the best
- 9 interest of the City to issue general obligation indebtedness to finance the costs of the Projects;

- 11 WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the Projects benefit the City's citizens and
- 12 residents, and that by combining the financing of the projects into a single plan of financing, the
- 13 Projects can be completed in a timely manner and at a reasonable cost.
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
- 15 OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, THAT:
- 16 <u>Section 1.</u> <u>AUTHORITY FOR THIS RESOLUTION.</u> This Resolution is adopted
- 17 pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as
- amended, the Charter and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, and
- other provisions of law (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act").
- 20 <u>Section 2.</u> <u>FINDINGS.</u> The City Commission hereby finds and determines that
- 21 the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct

and adopts the same as its findings and determinations and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 3. AUTHORIZATION OF THE BONDS. In accordance with the Florida Constitution, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended, the Charter and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, and other provisions of law, there shall be issued in one or more series, subject to the bond referendum hereinafter provided for (the "Bond Referendum Election"), bonds of the City in an aggregate principal amount (without regard to original issue discount or premium) not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Million Dollars (\$250,000,000) (the "Bonds") maturing at such time or times not exceeding thirty (30) years from their respective date or dates of issue, as may be determined by the City Commission and bearing interest at a rate or rates not exceeding the maximum lawful rate allowed by law, as shall be determined at the time of sale thereof, and to be payable from unlimited ad valorem taxes, for the purpose of providing funds, together with any other available funds, for paying the cost of the Projects. Proceeds from the Bonds shall be applied to the Projects.

Section 4. BOND REFERENDUM ELECTION. A Bond Referendum Election of the qualified electors residing in the City is hereby called and authorized to be held on March 11, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to determine whether or not the issuance of the Bonds in an aggregate principal amount (without regard to original issue discount or premium) not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Million Dollars (\$250,000,000) shall be approved by such qualified electors to finance the cost of the Projects. All qualified electors in the City shall be entitled and permitted to vote in the Bond Referendum Election. The places of voting for the

1 Referendum Bond Election shall be designated by the Supervisor of Elections of Broward

2 County, Florida (the "Supervisor of Elections").

The Supervisor of Elections shall hold, administer and conduct the Bond Referendum Election in the manner prescribed by law for holding special elections or referendum in the City and consistent with the City's agreement with the Supervisor of Elections. The City Clerk of the City (the "City Clerk") is directed to take all necessary measures to conduct the Bond Referendum Election in accordance with applicable law. The results shall be certified to the Department of State in accordance with Section 100.351, Florida Statutes. All procedures and requirements of the laws of the State of Florida, the Charter and the Code of Ordinances of the City and other applicable law shall be complied with for the purpose of conducting the computation of ballots and completion of bond referendum procedures.

The City Clerk is hereby designated and appointed as the official representative of the City Commission in all transactions with the Supervisor of Elections in relation to matters pertaining to the use of the registration books and the holding of said Bond Referendum Election.

Section 5. NOTICE OF BOND REFERENDUM. Notice of the Bond Referendum Election, including the time and location of polling places contemplated herein all in accordance with the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, as well as the State of Florida Election Code, as amended, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, at least twice, once in the fifth week and once in the third week prior to the week in which the Bond Referendum Election is held, the date of first publication in said newspaper to be at least thirty (30) days before said Bond Referendum Election, in substantially

- the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and in the manner provided in Section 100.342, Florida
- 2 Statutes. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish such notice.
- 3 <u>Section 6.</u> <u>OFFICIAL BALLOT.</u> The ballot for voting in the Bond Referendum
- 4 Election shall be in substantially the following form:

Section 7. EFFECT OF RESULTS. The return of the votes cast at said election shall be made to and canvassed by the Broward County Canvassing Board and the Broward County Canvassing Board shall declare the result. If a majority of the votes cast at such election in respect to the issuance of such Bonds shall be "For Bonds," such issuance shall be approved, and then the Bonds, the issuance of which shall be thereby approved, may be issued as hereafter provided by the City Commission and the Charter. If less than a majority of the votes cast at said election shall be "For Bonds," the Bonds for the improvements thereby affected shall be defeated, and no Bonds for such improvements shall be issued pursuant to this Resolution.

Notice is hereby given that a bond referendum will be held in the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida on Tuesday, March 11, 2025. The bond referendum election will be held to determine whether there shall be issued General Obligation Bonds (the "Bonds") of the City, in an aggregate principal amount (without regard to original issue discount or premium) not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Million Dollars (\$250,000,000). The Bonds shall be general obligations of the City and shall be secured by the full faith, credit, and unlimited ad valorem taxing power of the City. The Bonds may be issued in one or more series, shall mature in not more than thirty (30) years after issuance, and the Bonds shall bear interest at not exceeding the maximum rate permitted by law at the time of the sale of the Bonds. The monies received and interest earned from the issuance of the Bonds will be used to finance the Projects (as further specified in the Resolution). The Projects consists of construction and improvements, including, but not limited to: (i) a police station and public safety complex; (ii) new community facilities consisting of (a) renovations to the Plaza at Charles F. Dodge City Center, which include increase of event space, new road and drop off configuration, new lighting, drainage, signage, curbing, new gateway feature, and landscaping, and (b) installation of public art citywide; (iii) recreation facilities improvements consisting of park renovations, parking, drainage, landscaping, pavilions, walking paths, restroom upgrades, lighting, exercise equipment, playground equipment, signage, basketball courts, concession stands, golf course improvements, and renovation of recreational facilities at several parks within the City; (iv) roadway and infrastructure improvements consisting of widening lanes, construction of roads, drainage improvements, multi-use paths, sidewalk improvements, turn signals, intersection improvements, traffic calming, traffic control devices, signage, landscaping, and infrastructure improvements; and (v) acquisition of land for additional parks and affordable housing. From time to time, the City may include additional specifics concerning the Projects.
