Mayor and Commissioners,

At the June 17 Commission meeting, additional information was requested regarding the proposed sidewalk connection through Fiorendino Park. Attached for your review are several exhibits intended to provide additional context regarding the concept.

The attachment titled “CTS Segment Proposals for Fiorendino Park” is a conceptual layout of the proposed sidewalk improvements. Currently, the concrete sidewalk terminates at the west end of the park. The pathway then continues through the park as a mulch trail and ultimately terminates in the parking lot. The concept is to continue the sidewalk from its current endpoint and extend it through the park to connect with the existing sidewalk located just east of the entrance to Cedarwoods.

Also attached is a current aerial image of the Cedarwoods entrance showing how the existing sidewalk bends into the community, along with a conceptual exhibit illustrating how the proposed sidewalk could connect to that existing section. The final image is a rendering prepared by City staff to help visualize how the new sidewalk may integrate with the existing sidewalk that enters Cedarwoods.

As discussed during the meeting, the project remains in its infancy. The proposal before the Commission was to engage a civil engineering firm to prepare construction documents; however, the Commission deferred consideration of the item to allow for additional community input. As a result, neither the final alignment of the path nor the material to be used within the park (concrete or asphalt) has been determined. Those decisions would be evaluated and refined as part of the planning and design process should the project move forward.

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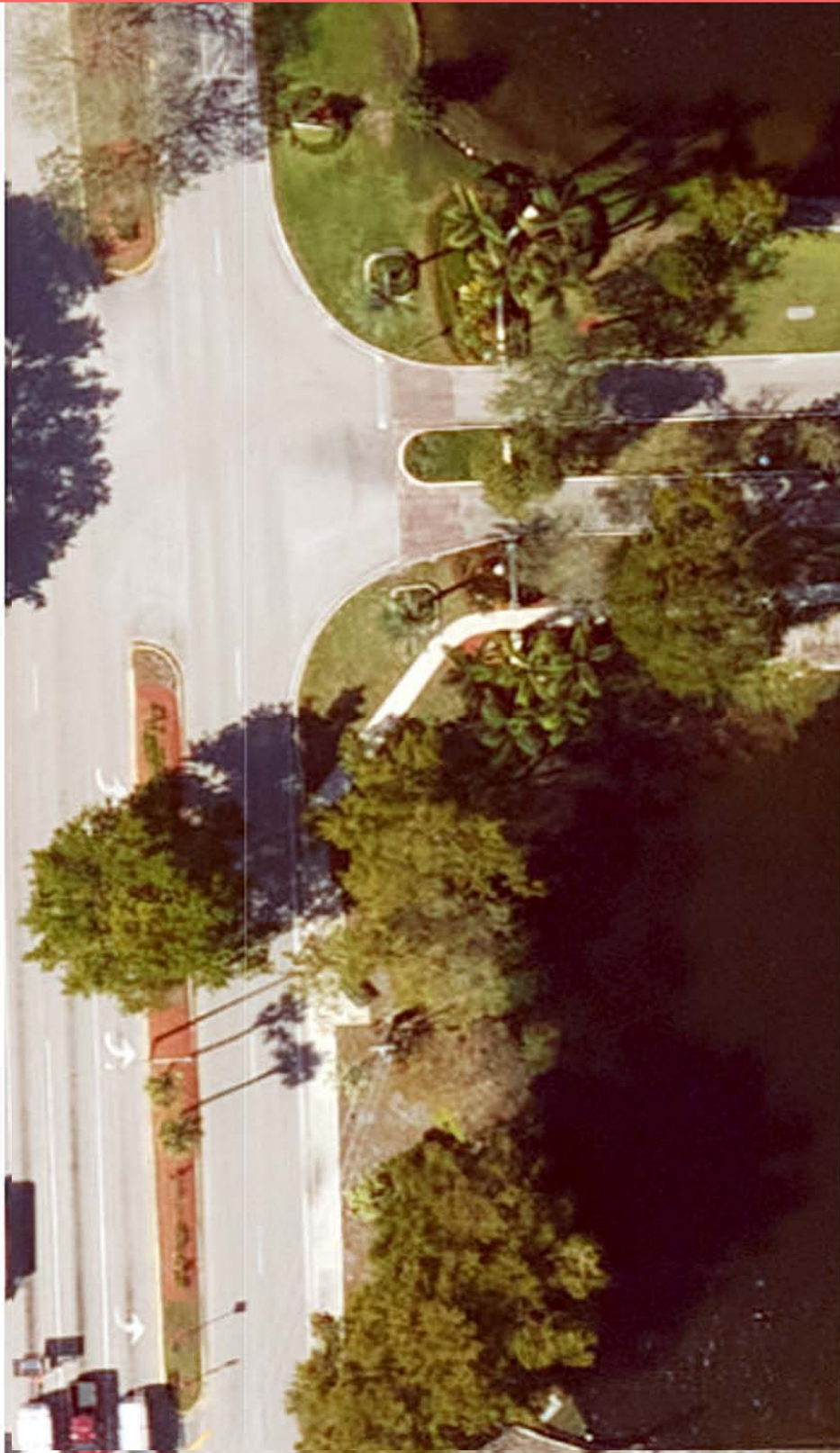
