**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS AGREEMENT WITH THE BROWARD COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS FOR THE CITY'S SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE CONDUCTED ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COUNTY-WIDE GENERAL ELECTION; DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION AND THE EXECUTED MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS AGREEMENT TO THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to call a special municipal election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026 (the "Special Municipal Election"), in conjunction with the county-wide November 3, 2026 General Election, wherein all qualified electors of the City of Pembroke Pines shall have the opportunity to consider and vote on two (2) proposed charter amendment questions and a possible General Obligation Bond referendum that are presently under consideration by City Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, each of the two (2) charter amendment ordinances approved on first reading by the City Commission and subsequently pending second reading, call for a Special Municipal Election to be conducted during the county general election on November 3, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution approving the possible General Obligation Bond referendum that will be under consideration by the City Commission shall, if adopted, call for a Special Municipal Election to be conducted during the county general election on November 3, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Broward County Supervisor of Elections (the "SOE") possesses the authority and jurisdiction to coordinate and administer elections throughout Broward

County, including special municipal elections within the City of Pembroke Pines; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to engage the SOE to carry out the duties, functions, obligations, and work required to conduct the Special Municipal Election as provided within the SOE's proposed Municipal Elections Agreement submitted to the City in connection with the Special Municipal Election; and

**WHEREAS**, the SOE has provided that the estimated cost to the City of Pembroke Pines to administer the Special Municipal Election is \$92,742.00, subject to adjustment based on the actual costs incurred by the SOE (true-up); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has determined that entering into the Municipal Elections Agreement with the Broward County Supervisor of Elections is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Pembroke Pines.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** The City Commission hereby approves the Municipal Elections Agreement for the City's Special Municipal Election to be conducted on November 3, 2026, and authorizes the execution thereof.

**Section 3.** The appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 4.** The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution and the executed Municipal Elections Agreement to the Broward County Supervisor of Elections.

**Section 5.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 6.** If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application,

it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

**Section 7.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
