What we are....

Children's Services Council of Broward County is a statutorily authorized special independent district overwhelmingly approved by Broward County voters in 2000 and reauthorized in 2014. CSC leverages a dedicated property tax up to 0.5 mills (50 cents for every \$1,000 of property value) to fund organizations that serve children and families across Broward County.

Through community collaboration, advocacy, and strategic funding, CSC brings partners together to address the specific needs of Broward's children and families and drive the best possible outcomes for their future.

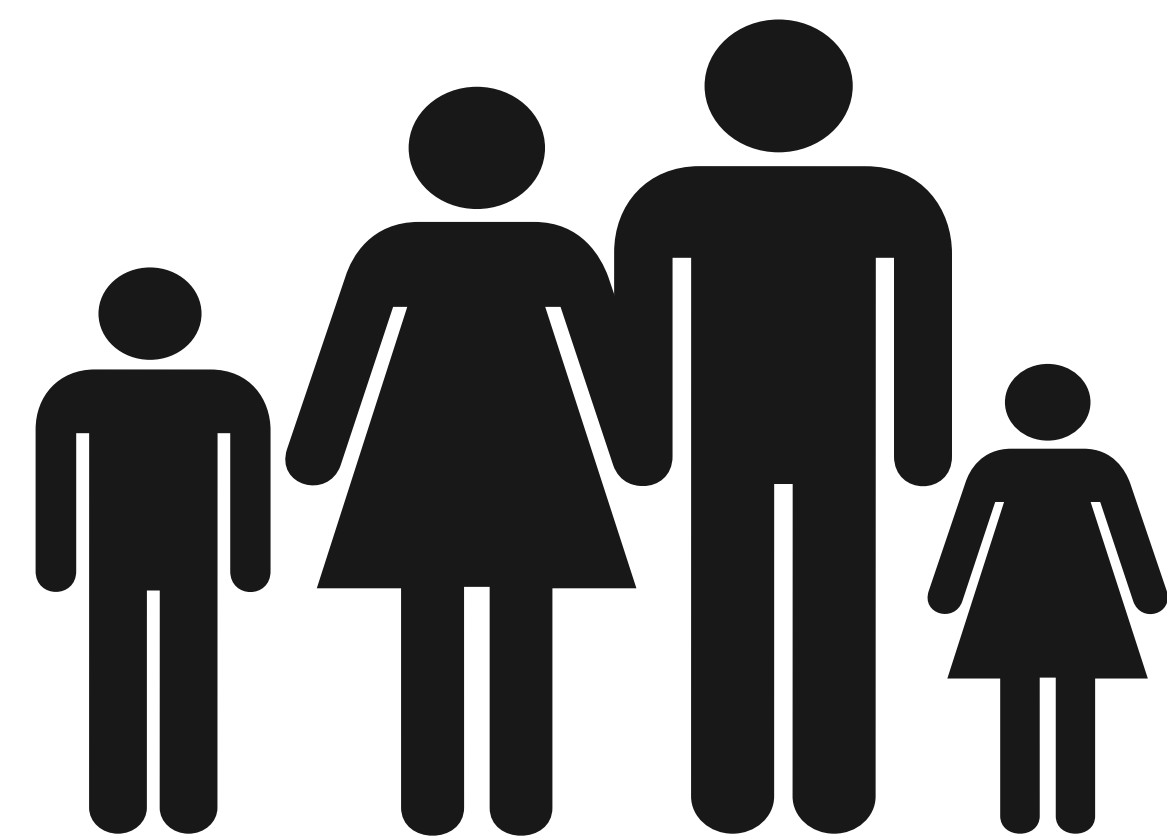

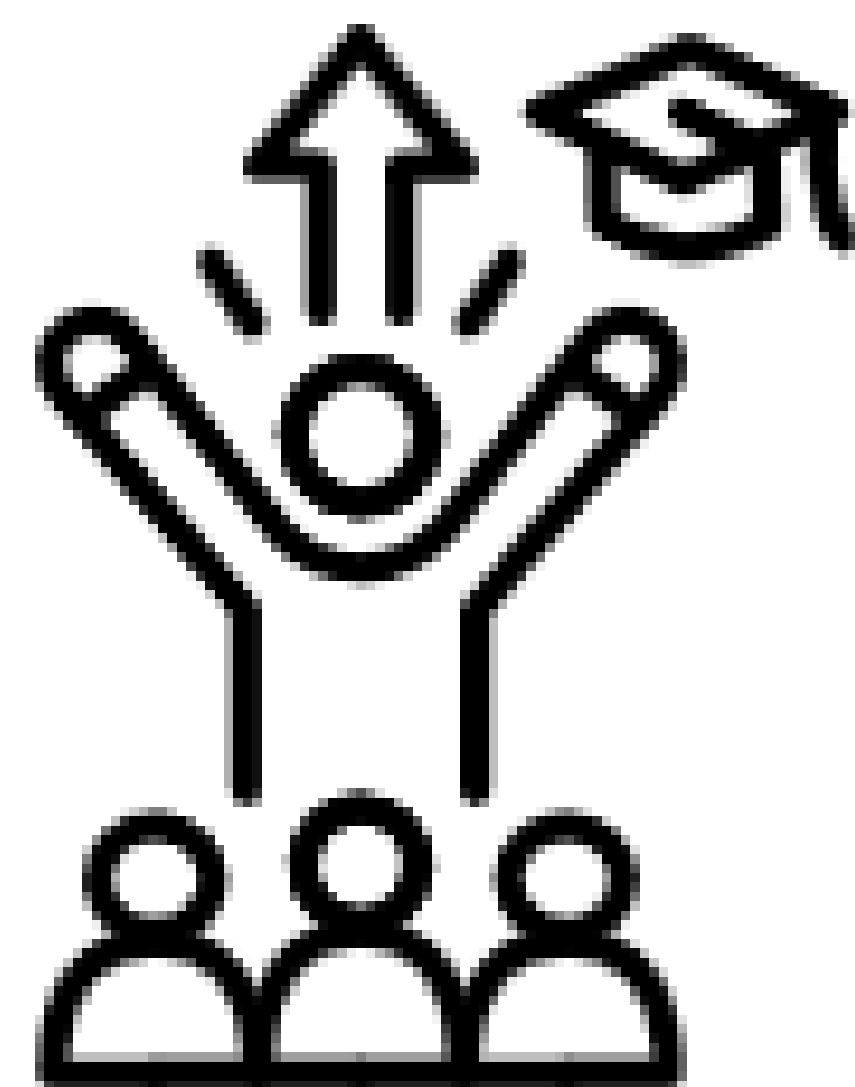

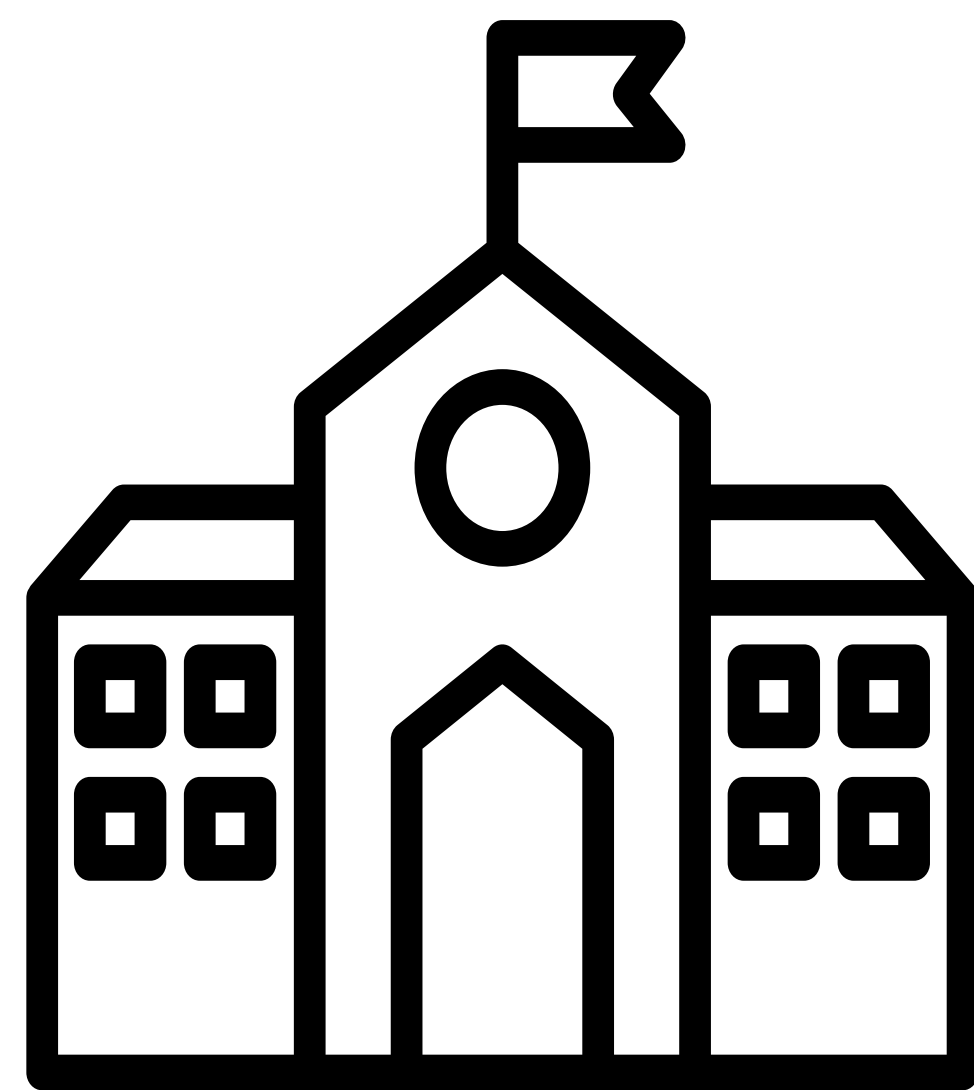

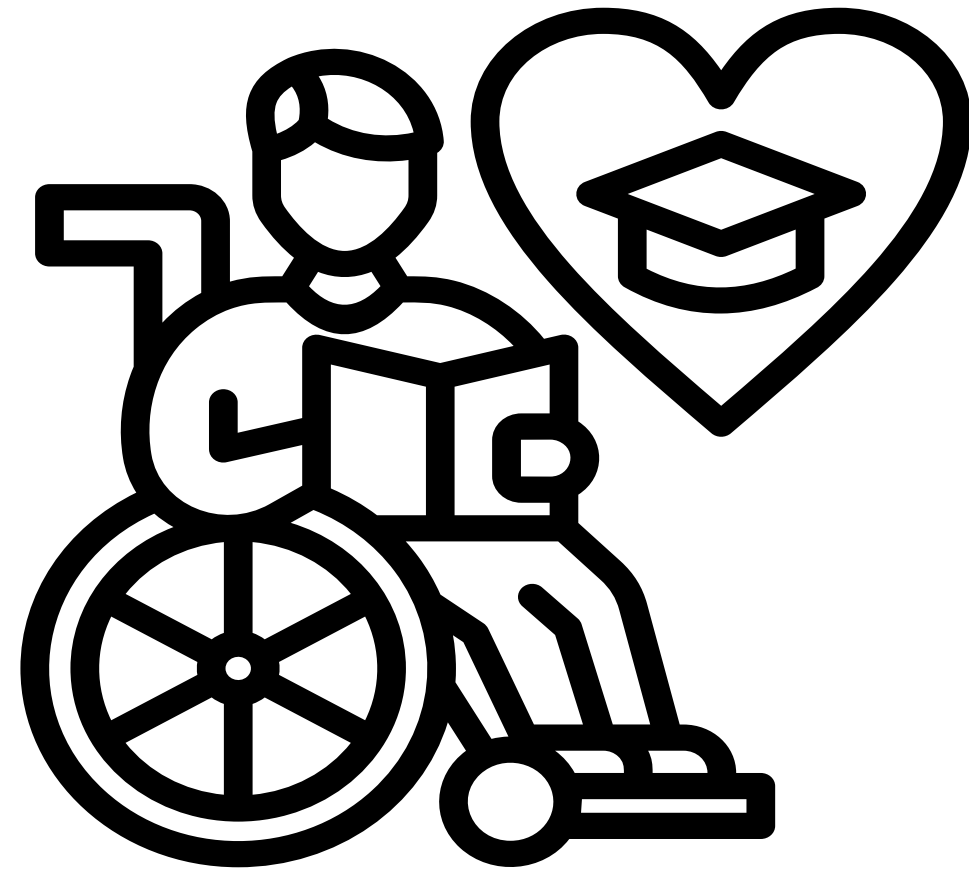
