RE: Update on Initiatives at North Perry Airport

Dear Mr. Dodge:

As a follow-up to a recent conversation with Mayor Castillo, we would like to take this opportunity to update you and the Commissioners for the City of Pembroke Pines on some of Broward County's initiatives related to North Perry Airport. As you may recall, following a town hall meeting, Broward County committed to moving forward with a new safety assessment study, a lead emission screening, and the reformation of the North Perry Airport Community Advisory Committee, among other items.

Below is an update on each of the three items:

1. **Safety Assessment Study** – The safety assessment study procurement is near completion having concluded contract negotiations this past Friday. Once the final form of contract is reviewed by the consultant and the County Attorney's Office it will be provided to the County's Purchasing Director for execution. Once approved, Broward County Aviation Department (BCAD) staff will promptly schedule a kick-off meeting with the consultant. It is anticipated that the contract will be in place in the next two weeks and it is estimated that the Consultant will need 12 months to complete the safety assessment study. As requested, we will coordinate a virtual meeting with your Mayor and the consultant performing the study.
2. **Lead Emission Screening** - The lead emission screening is also nearing completion of the procurement process. Negotiations are expected to begin with the number one ranked vendor shortly. Following successful negotiations, this procurement will also be forwarded to Broward County's Purchasing Director for

approval. It is anticipated that the Agreement will be in place by the end of June 2026, and it is estimated that the Consultant will need 3 months to complete the lead emission screening. With the safety assessment study, BCAD staff will arrange for a virtual meeting with your Mayor and the consultant performing the screening.

3. **North Perry Airport Community Advisory Committee** – As you are aware, the North Perry Airport Community Advisory Committee has been reinstated by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC). Seven of the 10 members have already been appointed to the new Committee. It is expected that the remaining members will be appointed soon. Shortly thereafter, a meeting will be scheduled for the new committee.

Additionally, District 7 County Commissioner Alexandra P. Davis and County staff met with representatives out of the Washington D.C. office of the Federal Aviation Administration on multiple items, including maintenance records, control tower, runway lighting, etc., and were provided with regional contact for additional follow-up.

Broward County remains committed to working with the City of Pembroke Pines regarding concerns the City may have about North Perry Airport. Should you have any additional questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to me or Mark Gale, Director of Aviation at 954-359-6199.
