**NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES)**

**REQUESTED ACTION:**

**MOTION TO APPROVE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AMONG UNINCORPORATED BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES TO SHARE THE RESOURCE BURDEN OF THE SYSTEM WIDE NPDES PERMIT REQUIREMENTS AND TO ALLOW BROWARD COUNTY TO CONDUCT SPECIFIC TECHNICAL ACITIVITIES REQUIRED BY THIS PERMIT.**

**SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:**

1. Following the Water Quality Act of 1997 the Environment Protection Agency has required States and Counties to obtain NPDES permit. Many cities in Broward County, including Pembroke Pines, have joint agreements with the county government to obtain this permit and followup on these requirements.
2. Broward County is requesting the cities to enter into an interlocal agreement which deals with the authorities and responsibilities of the cities and County.
3. **Under this agreement, the City will pay the County the sum of \$1,250 plus \$.375 per capita, 1990 Census Data.** The City of Pembroke Pines' initial share will be \$25,794.50 payable in four installments as shown in exhibit #2. Request Commission approval.


