A request for a Budget visioning session/workshop in preparation of the TRIM Notice and to address other budgetary items, meeting with the Broward County School Board about not closing public schools in the City of Pembroke Pines, to be scheduled no later than the first week in May, and about continuing former Commissioner Siple's initiative on the Raising Positive Children Forums.
