

1. Operational Impact

- How will the assignment of a Task Force Officer (TFO) with 30 hours in the Special Victims Unit and 10 hours in the Task Force affect staffing levels and service delivery in our Police Department?
 - There will be no disruption in service as the TFO is still being assigned cases within Pembroke Pines. Additionally, the TFO is subject to recall to assist with investigations in Pembroke Pines at any time.

2. Community Benefit and Accountability

- Participation in the FBI's Child Exploitation and Human Trafficking Task Force (CEHTTF) directly strengthens our community's safety by expanding the resources, intelligence, and investigative reach available to the Pembroke Pines Police Department.
- Our detectives gain immediate access to federal intelligence databases, technical resources, and specialized expertise that we would not otherwise have. This significantly increases our ability to identify offenders, dismantle exploitation networks, and support complex prosecutions that often cross state and national boundaries
- The primary mission of CEHTTF is to identify and recover victims of child exploitation and human trafficking. This partnership allows us to bring additional federal support to our most vulnerable victims, ensuring faster intervention and more comprehensive victim services
