TITLE: NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES)

REQUESTED ACTION:

MOTION TO APPROVE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES TO SHARE THE RESOURCE BURDEN OF THE SYSTEM WIDE NPDES PERMIT REQUIREMENTS AND TO ALLOW BROWARD COUNTY TO CONDUCT SPECIFIC TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES REQUIRED BY THIS PERMIT

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

1. On November 5, 1997 the City agreed to enter into an interlocal agreement with Broward County and all other municipalities in the county (except Fort Lauderdale and Hollywood) to submit all required applications and do all required technical work to meet the NPDES permit requirements. This agreement was for the first five-year NPDES MS4 permit period of December 3, 1996 through October 31, 2001.
2. Broward County has proposed a similar interlocal agreement that covers the second five-year NPDES permit period of 2002 through 2007.
3. Under this agreement the City will pay the County the total sum of \$98,971.00 in five annual installments as shown in exhibit 2. This sum is based on \$1,400 per municipality plus \$0.71 per capita, based on 2000 census data.
4. Engineering recommends that the city enter into the interlocal agreement with Broward County to meet the NPDES permit requirements.
