A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN ORGANIZATION'S ROADS FOR ECONOMIC VITALITY PROGRAM, CYCLE 1 FOR PROPOSED PROJECT – PEMBROKE ROAD FROM FLAMINGO ROAD TO HIATUS ROAD; DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (“MPO”) Approved the Roads for Economic Vitality (“REV”) on July 9th, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the project listed in Exhibit “A” will be evaluated and ranked by the MPO, then vetted to determine programmability in accordance with the REV policies; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Pembroke Pines Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (“LAP”) process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines commits to administer and deliver the project listed in Exhibit “A” under LAP; and

WHEREAS, the LAP program is reimbursement based as specified in the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines commits to funding upfront costs for design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, and construction to be then reimbursed as per the LAP agreement; and

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WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines commits to program funding commitments for construction contingency per the requirements of LAP; and

WHEREAS, the project listed in Exhibit “A” will be constructed within City’s right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City of Pembroke Pines, to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways under its jurisdiction after the project’s completion; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission finds that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and businesses of the City of Pembroke Pines, and serves a municipal and public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Commission supports the project listed in Exhibit “A.”

Section 3. The appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this resolution is held

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to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and adoption by the City Commission.

PRIORITY	PROJECT DESCRIPTION
1	<u>Pembroke Road From Flamingo Road to Hiatus Road Improvements:</u> Milling and resurfacing of Pembroke Road to facilitate 6’ wide buffered bike lanes between Flamingo Road and Hiatus Road and road widening on southbound lanes on Hiatus Rd, from SW 15th Street to Pembroke Road, to accommodate two left turn lanes. Project also includes minor pavement reconstruction, new signing and pavement markings, and the construction of new curb ramps to comply with ADA requirements.
