SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

1. On May 7, 2003, the City agreed to enter in a five year interlocal agreement with Broward County and all other municipalities in the county (except Fort Lauderdale and Hollywood) to submit all required applications and do all required technical work to meet the NPDES permit requirements. The agreement expired in 2007. A new agreement was anticipated in 2008 and in 2009 but the State of Florida has delayed the issuance of the new permit so no new agreement has been created by Broward County as of this date. Section 5.2 of the original agreement allowed the original agreement to remain in place until the new agreement was signed. It also allows the fee that Broward County charges to

increase by 5%.

2. A new five year agreement with Broward County will be brought back to the City Commission in 2011 once the State of Florida issues a new NPDES permit for Broward County and all other municipalities in the county that are part of the agreement.

3. The State of Florida has extended the current permit conditions until the new permit is issued. Broward County has continued to use the formula from the 2003 agreement to calculate the City's portion of the permit fee. The \$26,682 is based on the 2007 fee of \$23,049 (last year of the previous agreement) plus a yearly increase of 5%.

4. Motion to continue working with Broward County to share the resource burden of the system wide NPDES permit requirements and to allow Broward County to conduct specific technical activities required by the NPDES permit and authorize a payment of \$26,682 to Broward County.
