A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES CHARTER SCHOOLS SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE CHARTER SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2025 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year for the City of Pembroke Pines Charter Schools, sponsored by The School Board of Broward County, Florida, commenced July 1, 2025 and concluded June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3909 was adopted by the City Commission on June 18, 2025 providing the budget for the revenues and expenditures of the Pembroke Pines Charter Schools ("Charter Schools") for the Fiscal Year of the Charter Schools sponsored by The School Board of Broward County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, due to changes in revenues and expenditures in the Charter Schools' Budget throughout the fiscal year it is necessary to amend the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Charter Schools' Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Charter Schools' 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Budget is hereby amended in accordance with **Exhibit "A,"** which is attached hereto, incorporated herein, and expressly made a part hereof.

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SECTION 3. The funds appropriated for the expenditures designated in the Amended Budget include state-shared revenues received from the State of Florida, federal and state grants, as well as contributions received from various benefactors.

SECTION 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
