REQUIRE THAT IN ALL CITY PROCUREMENTS, ALL CITY EMPLOYEES, AS PUBLIC OFFICERS, SHALL NOT INVEST OR HOLD ANY INVESTMENT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY IN ANY FINANCIAL BUSINESS, COMMERCIAL OR OTHER PRIVATE TRANSACTION WITH ANY VENDOR OF GOODS OR SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE CITY THAT CREATES A CONFLICT WITH ONE'S OFFICIAL DUTIES AS **EMPLOYEE** CITY AND AS Α PUBLIC FURTHER. EACH CITY EMPLOYEE AS A PUBLIC OFFICER SHALL DISCLOSE IN SUCH SITUATIONS ALL SUCH PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS IN ANY INSTANCE WHERE THERE COULD BE A CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR AN APPEARANCE OF A CONFLICT IN CONNECTION WITH ANY SUCH CITY PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES.
