



SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE, RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING, AND COMMERCIAL WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES AND WASTE PRO OF FLORIDA, INC.

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT (“Second Amendment”), dated this ____ day of September, 2023, is entered into by and between:

THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, a municipal corporation organized and operating under the laws of the State of Florida, with an address of **601 City Center Way, Pembroke Pines, FL 33025,** hereinafter referred to as "CITY",

and

WASTE PRO OF FLORIDA, INC., a For Profit Corporation, as listed with the Florida Division of Corporations, with a business address of **2101 W SR 434, 3rd Floor, Longwood, FL. 32779,** hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR".

“CITY” and “CONTRACTOR” may hereinafter be referred to collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a “Party”.

WHEREAS, on **September 1, 2021,** the Parties entered into the Agreement for residential solid waste, residential recycling, and commercial waste collection services (“Original Agreement”) for an initial period commencing on January 2, 2022 at 12:00 AM and expiring on September 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement authorized the renewal thereof at the expiration of the initial term for **one (1) additional seven (7) year** term pursuant to written amendments to the Original Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2022, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Original Agreement allowing residents the use of existing blue carts bearing a decal, for co-mingled solid waste collection, once per week on their previously scheduled recycling days; and,

WHEREAS, it is essential to the CITY’s ability to provide for the health, safety, welfare, and wellness of its residents to exercise every viable option related to enhancing the provision, efficiency, and cost of waste collection and disposal services; and

WHEREAS, the CITY has determined that a change in the Designated Disposal Facility is necessary, effective October 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, to date the Parties have been satisfied with the performance and execution of the Original Agreement and subsequent First Amendment and desire to enter into this Second



Amendment relating to the Designated Disposal Facility.

WITNESSETH

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of the mutual covenants and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as set forth below:

SECTION 1. The recitations set forth in the above "WHEREAS" clauses are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. Any language contained in this Second Amendment, or any subsequent amendment, which is in ~~struckthrough type~~ shall be deletions from the terms of the Original Agreement and language in underlined type shall be additions to the terms of the Original Agreement.

SECTION 3. Section 3.15 of the Original Agreement is hereby revised and amended as set forth below:

3.15 Disposal Location

3.15.1 CONTRACTOR shall be required to deliver all collected Residential Waste to the Disposal Facility(ies), except where CONTRACTOR complies with the requirements of the City's Interlocal Agreement with Broward County, or any other agreement, for delivery of waste outside the State.

3.15.2 Disposal Facility – Effective October 1, 2023, All residential and commercial garbage Waste collected shall be delivered by CONTRACTOR to a permitted solid waste disposal facility operating in compliance with applicable federal, state, and local laws. The CITY has determined that the Wheelabrator South Broward, Inc. South Disposal Waste to Energy Facility the Waste Connection Deerfield Beach Recycling and Transfer Facility located at 1751 S.W. 43rd Terrace, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442-4400 South State Road 7, Davie, Florida shall be used as the Disposal Facility for this agreement. CONTRACTOR shall be authorized to deliver waste to the Disposal Facility(ies) from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, during every day ifof the year, excluding Christmas and Sundays, or as approved otherwise by the City's Contract Administrator.

3.15.3 Alternate Disposal Facility – In the event that the designated Disposal Facility is rendered incapable, for any reason, to receive waste for any length of time, or should the CITY determine that it is necessary to change Disposal Facilities, the CONTRACTOR shall be required to dispose of the waste at the following Alternate Disposal Facility(ies):

- (i) ~~Monarch Hill Landfill, 2700 Wiles Road, Pompano Beach, Florida 33073~~



- (ii) ~~Okeechobee Landfill Facility, 10800 N.E. 128th Avenue, Florida 33972~~
- (i) Waste Connection Pembroke Park Recycling and Transfer Facility, 1899 S.W. 31st Street, Pembroke Park, Florida 33009
- ~~(iii)~~ (ii) such other disposal facility as may be approved by Broward County CITY.

3.15.4 Tare Weight - TARE weights are used by material receiving facilities to calculate the final disposal charge ~~the City pays~~. These weights need to be validated each year. Depending on the scale system in use at the disposal facility, CONTRACTOR may be required to assist the City by weighing each collection truck in & out three times and recording the information on a TARE WEIGHT REPORT. The average TARE Weight shall be used by the disposal facility and the City to validate disposal charges. In the event that the ~~City's~~ disposal facilities change their scale or the City changes disposal facilities, CONTRACTOR may be required to re-weigh the trucks to re-determine the average TARE Weights for each truck.

3.15.5 Potential Changes to the Disposal Facility and Location – With the understanding that the City may need to change its Disposal Facility and location, the City has included **Exhibit D** which has a map that shows a 10 mile Radius Rings from the center of Pines Boulevard and Flamingo Road.

3.15.5.1 The Collection portion of the Fees outlined in this agreement shall be applicable to any Disposal Facility that may be located in the 1030 mile radius ring.

3.15.5.2 In the event that CONTRACTOR proposes a change to the designated Disposal Facility; (a) If the CITY agrees to the requested change of the designated Disposal Facility to another Disposal Facility that has a higher Disposal Fee, for some or all of the Waste, the CONTRACTOR shall hold the Disposal Fee portion of the rates at the rates set forth in this Agreement, and any future adjustments to the Disposal Fee portion of the rates, as outlined in Section 4.4.1, shall be based on the Disposal Facility and rates that were set forth in Exhibit "C." (b) If the CONTRACTOR cannot hold the Disposal Fee portion of the rates, the CITY may negotiate the Disposal Fee portion of the rates with the CONTRACTOR due to the requested change in the Disposal Facility and the rates set forth by the proposed Disposal Facility for some or all of the Waste. In the event that the PARTIES agree to change the Disposal Facility, Exhibit "C" shall be updated with the agreed upon rates, which shall be used as the new base for any future adjustments to the Disposal Fee portion of the rates, as outlined in Section 4.4.1.

3.15.5.3 In the event that CITY proposes a change to the designated Disposal Facility, the CITY shall negotiate the Disposal Fee portion of the rates with the CONTRACTOR due to the requested change in the Disposal Facility and the rates set forth by the proposed Disposal Facility for some or all of the Waste. In the event that the PARTIES agree to change the Disposal Facility, Exhibit "C" shall be updated with the agreed upon rates, which shall be used as the new base for any



future adjustments to the Disposal Fee portion of the rates, as outlined in Section 4.4.1.

3.15.5.4 Should the CITY be required by an agreement it has for solid waste disposal services with Broward County or another entity established to provide waste disposal facilities for local governments in Broward County, including entities established by state law, local ordinance or interlocal agreement, and the PARTIES are not able to renegotiate the Fees, then CITY may terminate this Agreement pursuant to the process in Section 14.2.

SECTION 4. Good faith negotiations pertaining to the change of disposal facility were undertaken and the PARTIES have agreed to that the Disposal Fee portion of the rates with CONTRACTOR shall not be affected by this change in Disposal Facility(ies), as set forth in the attached updated Exhibit "C".

SECTION 5. Sections 4.4.1 of the Original Agreement is hereby revised and amended as set forth below:

4.4.1 Turnkey – The Commercial Waste Collection Service Category shall be a Turnkey Solution. The CITY shall utilize the Disposal Fee(s) in Exhibit "C" and the CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for paying the Tipping Fees at the disposal site.

~~City is not participating in Broward County's centralized billing services under its Interlocal Agreement between the City and Broward County for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services. CONTRACTOR acknowledges that the Interlocal Agreement requires a license agreement between it and the City that includes specific payment procedures for Commercial Waste Disposal Services, and Disposal Facility requires the posting of a reasonable performance payment bond in a form and by an issuer reasonably acceptable to Wheelabrator Environmental Services, Inc. for the Disposal Service Charges to the Disposal Facility, in an amount calculated as required by the Interlocal Agreement. CONTRACTOR and City shall enter into the license agreement prior to CONTRACTOR collecting and disposing of Commercial Solid Waste under this Agreement. CONTRACTOR acknowledges that if CONTRACTOR does not pay the amounts due to the Disposal Facility when due, the Disposal Facility shall notify the CONTRACTOR and if payment is not made within 15 days of notice, the Disposal Facility may discontinue the delivery/acceptance of any materials until such past due invoices are paid.~~

In the event that there is a change to the tipping fee at the Disposal Facility, the Disposal Fee portion of the rates shall be adjusted by re-calculating the Disposal Fees based on the percent of change in the tipping fee at the Disposal Facility.

SECTION 6. Sections 4.5 of the Original Agreement is hereby revised and amended as set forth below:

4.5 INITIAL RATES AND CPI ADJUSTMENTS - The initial collection rates and delivery fees as more specifically described in Exhibit "C," shall remain firm for an initial period of approximately two years, ending on September 30, 2023 at 11:59 PM. On October 1st 2023, and



annually thereafter, the collection component of the monthly rate shall be automatically increased according to the annual Consumers Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI/U), Seasonally Adjusted as published by U. S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics in the Detailed Report Series ID: CUSR0000SEHG – “Water and Sewer and Trash Collection Services” in U.S. city average for the annual change for the month of April or 3.5%, whichever is less but not less than zero.

SECTION 7. Sections 6.6.4, 6.6.5 and 6.7.2 of the Original Agreement is hereby revised and amended as set forth below:

6.6.4 Umbrella/Excess Liability Insurance in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 as determined appropriate by the CITY depending on the type of job and exposures contemplated. Coverage must be follow form of the General Liability, Auto Liability and Employer’s Liability. This coverage shall be maintained for a period of no less than the later of three (3) years after the delivery of goods/services or final payment pursuant to this Agreement.

The City of Pembroke Pines and ~~Wheelabrator Environmental Services, Inc.~~ Waste Connections of Florida, Inc., must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage. The CITY’s additional insured status shall extend to any coverage beyond the minimum limits of liability found herein.

6.6.5 Environmental/Pollution Liability insurance shall be required with a limit of no less than \$1,000,000 per wrongful act. Coverage shall include: CONTRACTOR’s completed operations, sudden, accidental and gradual pollution conditions. This coverage shall be maintained for a period of no less than the later of three (3) years after the delivery of goods/services or final payment pursuant to this Agreement. Retroactive date, if any, to be no later than the first day of service to the CITY.

The City of Pembroke Pines and ~~Wheelabrator Environmental Services, Inc.~~ Waste Connections of Florida, Inc., must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage. The CITY’s additional insured status shall extend to any coverage beyond the minimum limits of liability found herein.

6.7.2 ~~Wheelabrator Environmental Services, Inc.~~ Waste Connections of Florida, Inc., shall be named as an Additional Insured on each of the Liability Policies required herein.

SECTION 8. Section 7.3 of the Original Agreement is hereby revised and amended as set forth below:

7.3 CONTRACTOR hereby additionally agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless ~~Wheelabrator Environmental Services, Inc.~~ Waste Connections of Florida, Inc., from and against any and all claims, suits, actions, damages, or causes of action arising during the term of this Contract/Franchise, for any personal or bodily injury, loss of life, or damage to property arising directly or indirectly from CONTRACTOR's negligence or intentional misconduct arising directly or indirectly from its delivery of waste to a Disposal Facility.



SECTION 9. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity by and between the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment, and the Original Agreement and the First Amendment, the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment shall control to the extent of any such conflict or ambiguity.

SECTION 10. The Parties agree that in all other respects the Original Agreement and First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect, except as specifically modified herein.

SECTION 11. Each exhibit referred to in the Original Agreement and First Amendment, except as repealed herein, forms an essential part of this Second Amendment. The exhibits, if not physically attached, should be treated as part of this Second Amendment and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 12. Each person signing this Second Amendment on behalf of either Party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Second Amendment on behalf of the Party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such Party with respect to all provisions contained in this Section Amendment.

SECTION 13. This Second Amendment may be executed by hand or electronically in multiple originals or counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Execution and delivery of this Section Amendment by the Parties shall be legally binding, valid and effective upon delivery of the executed documents to the other Party through facsimile transmission, email, or other electronic delivery.
