# WHAT IS THE GREEN SCHOOLS CAMPAIGN?

- The Broward Green Schools Campaign is a part of The Climate Reality Project's national network of local campaigns aiming to transition educational institutions to 100% clean energy.
- Within Broward County's campaign the Broward Sierra Group -Junior Team is calling for a transition to 100% clean energy, and electrification of school busses.

## WE NEED 100% CLEAN ENERGY FOR OUR SCHOOLS

- Annually, schools in the United States are spending \$8 billion on energy and emit an estimated 72 million metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent to the output of 18 coal plants.
- CO2 emissions contribute to increased frequency of extreme heat; instances of extreme heat lead to higher rates of heat related illness, and can be dangerous to predisposed groups and individuals.
- Broward County has already taken began taking action to reducing its carbon emissions, and Green Schools is the next step.

### OUR DEMAND

- The Broward Green Schools Campaign is calling for Broward County Public Schools to transition to 100% clean energy by 2030
- BCPS can request funding from the IRA to help fund these projects
- This would include the use of electric school buses, solar panels, the use of geothermal energy, and more examples of clean energy.


