A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES CHARTER SCHOOLS SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE CHARTER SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year for the City of Pembroke Pines Charter Schools, sponsored by The School Board of Broward County, Florida, commenced July 1, 2024 and concluded June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3870 was adopted by the City Commission on June 18, 2024 providing the budget for the revenues and expenditures of the Pembroke Pines Charter Schools ("Charter Schools") for the Fiscal Year of the Charter Schools sponsored by The School Board of Broward County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, due to changes in revenues and expenditures in the Charter Schools' Budget throughout the fiscal year it is necessary to amend the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Charter Schools' Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Charter Schools' 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Budget is hereby amended in accordance with **Exhibit "A,"** which is attached hereto, incorporated herein, and expressly made a part hereof.
