In business he began his career with New York Life Insurance Company rising to become the youngest Head of the Accounting Section soon after his return from his military stint as a decorated Combat Engineer with the 101st Airborne Division in the then Republic of South Viet^{et}Nam. With stops to further his education in the Catholic University of Puerto Rico where, as a business major student, he was an ESOL Assistant Professor instructing and mentoring the Freshman and Sophomore classes in English. During his years in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico he honed his business acumen with positions as Sales Manager of an island wide office supply corporation, an on-air personality with WZAR-FM, and Manager of Ortho-Medic Supply. In May 1982, after the birth of his second son, he entered the then Metro-Dade Police Academy as a Police Recruit. In October 1982 he was duly sworn in as an MDPD Deputy Sheriff. In the 1983 Officer Rosario was selected as a Field Training Officer instructing and evaluating new Police Officer recruits. In October 1984 he was selected as a Detective with MDPD Organized Crime Bureau. Detective Rosario's Law Enforcement career encompassed decades of investigative duties all in the realm of Major Crimes, including stints with FBI/US Customs Organized Cargo Theft Task Force, Organized Traditional (La Costa Nostra) Investigations, Vice/Gambling, Major Narcotics investigations, Kidnapping/Extortion, Money Laundering and Election Fraud. Mr. Rosario is considered an expert in fields that include Electronic Surveillance, Undercover Operations, Public Corruption Investigations, Organized Crime, Mortgage and Election Fraud. Mr. Rosario was the 2002 Department of Justice, U.S. Attorney's Office Law Enforcement Officer of the Year. Mr. Rosario retired from MDPD in 2003 from the Public Corruption Investigations Bureau as a founding Detective. In August 2005, Mr. Rosario returned to Public Service as a Special Agent of the Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust (COE). The COE is the watch guard and holds jurisdictional authority regarding any violations of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest Ordinance. Mr. Rosario retired from the COE in November 2012. Mr. Rosario was the founding owner and manager of Moonstone Investigations LLC. (MSI). MSI, due to its extensive experience and expertise, engaged in Campaign Research with numerous Political Candidates for Public / Government elected officials, thus ensuring campaigns ran on Ethical Principles. These successful campaigns resulted in successful races for many Mayors / Commissioners. MSI also held Security Guard contracts with Miami-Dade College and Miami-Dade Water & Sewer Department. During his ownership at MSI, Mr. Rosario was hired as a Special Agent for the FT. Lauderdale branch of the Florida Bar investigating possible Florida Attorneys violations of their OATH. Mr. Rosario sold his corporate interests in MSI in 2020. As an Owner Resident since 2005, Mr. Rosario, beginning in 2012, held positions in Park Place as Chairman of the Hearing Committee, current Elm Building Director, Member of the PPOA Board, current Chairman of the Insurance Committee, previous Board Vice-President and
