

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES
PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
TO CDBG PROGRAM YEAR 2019
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG-CV)**

The City of Pembroke Pines is an entitlement recipient of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV). The CDBG-CV funds were allocated to combat COVID-19. The City has adopted a One-Year Action Plan that is consistent with its 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development Programs and will amend its 2019-2020 Action Plan. The following amends the previously approved Action Plans. The amendment is summarized below.
