- (1) Period for municipality to hold 1st Public Hearing
- (2) Per Florida Statute 200.065(2)(e)2 public municipal hearings cannot be held on the same day as County or School Board hearings.
- (3) All hearings must be held after 5:00 p.m. Monday Friday or anytime on Saturday. Hearings cannot be held on Sunday (s. 200.065 (2)(e)2., F.S.).
- (4) Per Florida Statute 166.041(3)(a), the Notice of Enactment must be advertised at least 10 days prior to adoption of the ordinance therefore the millage rate ordinance has to be approved at least 3 days prior to publication of the Notice.
- (5) Reduces the number of meeting days by scheduling the Pines Commission meeting with Budget Hearing
- (6) Commission will attend 3 meetings during September.
- (7) Allows for the maximum 5 days between advertisement and 2nd hearing.
