CES has been awarded numerous school renovation projects in the Broward County school district including:

Pembroke Pines Elementary School – Pembroke Pines FL
Size 98,500 sf | Cost \$3 million | Design Completion April 2018, Construction September 2019

Acting as prime design professional, CES is currently providing upgrades to the security, building envelope, media center, HVAC and electrical systems. Emergency exit signage will be replaced and systems will be brought into compliance with current life safety codes. The media center will be completely renovated to bring the facility up to date with today's standards. HVAC mechanical and electrical building systems will be replaced including exterior chiller and rooftop units, controls and hydronic systems. Electrical deficiencies including canopy and building mounted lighting will be addressed. Aluminum windows are slated for replacement and the majority of the campus buildings will be re-roofed. Work will initiate during the school year without interruption to normal school activities or safety. The majority of the work will be completed during 2017 & 2018 summer breaks.

Ramblewood Middle School – Coral Springs FL
Size 168,800 sf | Cost \$4 million | Design Completion April 2018, Construction September 2019

Ramblewood Middle School, built in 1976 and renovated in 1989 and 2004, is slated to receive multiple renovations. Acting as prime design professional, CES is currently providing upgrades to the security, building envelope, media center, HVAC and electrical systems. Emergency exit signage and wall pack lighting will be replaced. Fire sprinkler systems will be designed and installed in buildings 1 & 2 to meet current life safety code standards. The media center will be completely renovated to bring the facility up to date with today's standards. Mechanical deficiencies including conducting HVAC test and balance in multiple buildings will be addressed. Electrical deficiencies including building and pole mounted lighting and the replacement of switchgears and panelboards will be remedied. The majority of the work will be completed during 2017 & 2018 summer breaks.

 Built in 1995, this 6 building campus requires upgrades to the building envelope, HVAC and full replacement of the fire suppression system. CES as the prime design professional is also tasked with identifying any additional deficiencies.

EQUAL BENEFITS CERTIFICATION FORM FOR DOMESTIC PARTNERS AND ALL MARRIED COUPLES

Except where federal or state law mandates to the contrary, a Contractor awarded a Contract pursuant to a competitive solicitation shall provide benefits to Domestic Partners and spouses of its employees, irrespective of gender, on the same basis as it provides benefits to employees' spouses in traditional marriages.

The Contractor shall provide the City and/or the City Manager or his/her designee, access to its records for the purpose of audits and/or investigations to ascertain compliance with the provisions of this section, and upon request shall provide evidence that the Contractor is in compliance with the provisions of this section upon each new bid, contract renewal, or when the City Manager has received a complaint or has reason to believe the Contractor may not be in compliance with the provisions of this section. Records shall include but not be limited to providing the City and/or the City Manager or his/her designee with certified copies of the Contractor's records pertaining to its benefits policies and its employment policies and practices.

The Contractor must conspicuously make available to all employees and applicants for employment the following statement:

“During the performance of a contract with the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, the Contractor will provide Equal Benefits to its employees with spouses, as defined by Section 35.39 of the City's Code of Ordinances, and its employees with Domestic Partners and all Married Couples”.

The posted statement must also include a City contact telephone number and email address which will be provided to each contractor when a covered contract is executed.

SECTION 1 DEFINITIONS

1. **Benefits** means the following plan, program or policy provided or offered by a contractor to its employees as part of the employer's total compensation package which may include but is not limited to sick leave, bereavement leave, family medical leave, and health benefits.
2. **Cash Equivalent** mean the amount of money paid to an employee with a domestic partner or spouse in lieu of providing benefits to the employee's domestic partner or spouse. The cash equivalent is equal to the employer's direct expense of providing benefits to an employee for his or her spouse from a traditional marriage.
3. **Covered Contract** means a contract between the City and a contractor awarded subsequent to the date when this section becomes effective valued at over \$25,000 or the threshold amount required for competitive bids as required in section 35.18(A) of the Procurement Code.
4. **Domestic Partner** shall mean any two (2) adults of the same or different sex who have registered as domestic partners with a governmental body pursuant to state or local law authorizing such registration, or with an internal registry maintained by the employer of at least one of the domestic partners. A contractor may institute an internal registry to allow for the provision of equal benefits to employees with domestic partners who do not register their partnerships pursuant to a governmental body authorizing such registration, or who are

located in a jurisdiction where no such governmental domestic partnership registry exists. A contractor that institutes such registry shall not impose criteria for registration that are more stringent than those required for domestic partnership registration by the City of Pembroke Pines.

5. **Equal benefits** means the equality of benefits between employees with spouses and/or dependents of spouses and employees with domestic partners and/or dependents of domestic partners, and/or between spouses of employees and/or dependents of spouses and domestic partners of employees and/or dependents of domestic partners.
6. **Spouse** means one member of a married pair legally married under the laws of any state within the United States of America or any other jurisdiction under which such marriage is legally recognized, irrespective of gender.
7. **Traditional marriage** means a marriage between one man and one woman.
