**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE WIDENING OF PEMBROKE ROAD FROM SW 160<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO SW 184<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE PROJECT CONTAINED IN THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S COMMITMENT 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN COST FEASIBLE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has requested that the City adopt a resolution expressing support for a list of projects in Pembroke Pines; and

**WHEREAS**, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") approved the draft *Commitment 2045* Metropolitan Transportation Plan ("MTP") Cost Feasible Plan on May 9, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the widening of Pembroke Road from SW 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue is listed in the Cost Feasible Plan, has been identified as a transportation need, and is currently a ranked project in the approved draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the MPO requires that the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission approve a Resolution expressing support for the projects listed in the Cost Feasible Plan in order for the projects to be included in the final 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Pembroke Pines commits to working with the MPO, transportation partners, and the public to prepare the project(s) for programming in the Broward MPO's Transportation Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission finds that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and businesses of the City of Pembroke Pines, and serves a municipal and public purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing "**WHEREAS**" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct are made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City supports the widening of Pembroke Road from SW 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue as listed in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization approved Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan.

**Section 3:** That the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient in order to carry out the aims of this Resolution.

**Section 4.** If any clause, section, or other part or application this Resolution shall be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force and effect.
