WHEREAS, the conceptual Pines Boulevard at Flamingo Road Center

Turn Overpass Project is listed in the Cost Feasible Plan, has been identified as

a transportation need, and is currently a ranked project in the approved draft

2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan; and

WHEREAS, the conceptual Pines Boulevard and Flamingo Road Center

Turn Overpass is subject to additional analysis, coordination, evaluation, and

public outreach, and

WHEREAS, the MPO will work with the City and the Florida Department of Transportation to identify alternatives to address congestion issues at the intersection of Pines Boulevard and Flamingo Road; and

WHEREAS, the MPO requires that the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission approve a Resolution expressing support for the projects listed in the Cost Feasible Plan in order for the projects to be included in the final 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines commits to working with the MPO, transportation partners, and the public to prepare the project(s) for programming in the Broward MPO's Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission has the ability to remove the conceptual project from the Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan at any time prior to the selection of an alternative at the conclusion of the Project Development & Environment Study; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines City Commission finds that the approval of this Resolution is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and businesses of the City of Pembroke Pines, and serves a municipal and public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct are made a specific part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City supports the <u>conceptual</u> Pines Boulevard at Flamingo Road Center Turn Overpass <u>Project</u> as listed in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization approved Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan.

Section 3: That the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient in order to carry out the aims of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4</u>. If any clause, section, or other part or application this Resolution shall be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force and effect.
