COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Broward College Police Academy meets all basic training requirements of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the Criminal Justice Standards and Training, State Officer Certification Exam. Students must pass the Florida State Officer Certification examination to qualify for Florida State Law Enforcement certification, as prescribed in Chapter 943.17(1), F.S.

TUITION
