> PURPOSE: RECOMPUTE AND PUBLICLY ANNOUNCE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 5.6736, WHICH IS 5.21% ABOVE THE ROLLED-BACK MILLAGE RATE OF 5.3924 AND AMEND AND ADOPT TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR GENERAL FUND, UTILITY FUND, AND ALL OTHER FUNDS OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, AND INVITE THE PUBLIC TO SPEAK REGARDING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE AND BUDGET.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2019-16 IS AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 5.6736 OR \$5.6736 PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF TAXABLE ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE, WHICH IS 5.21% ABOVE THE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 5.3924, FOR THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO THE 2019-2020 CITY BUDGET, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 200, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND ESTABLISHING THE DEBT SERVICE MILLAGE RATE OF 0.4464 FOR DEBT SERVICE ON THE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS APPROVED BY THE ELECTORATE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FORAN EFFECTIVE DATE.
