A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, NAMING AND DEDICATING N.W. 125th AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES “ABRAHAMS-TORRES AVENUE” IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 100.02 OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES CODE OF ORDINANCES; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO BROWARD COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2011, Alexandra Abrahams, a 14-year old resident of the City was killed when a driver struck her at the intersection of Taft Street and N.W. 125th Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, in 2018, Cassie Tianna Torres, a 15-year old resident of the City was killed when a driver struck her bicycle at the intersection of Taft Street and N.W. 125th Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, Alexandra Abrahams and Cassie Tianna Torres were both students at Flanagan High School and residents of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to honor the memories of both Alexandra Abrahams and Cassie Tianna Torres; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 100.02 of the City’s Code of Ordinances, the City Commission finds it to be in the best interests of the citizens

and residents of the City to name and dedicate N.W. 125th Avenue within the City of Pembroke Pines "Abrahams-Torres Avenue."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, in accordance with Section 100.02 of the City's Code of Ordinances, hereby names and dedicates N.W. 125th Avenue within the City of Pembroke Pines "Abrahams-Torres Avenue," as a secondary street name.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation and the Broward Legislative Delegation.

Section 4. The City Commission hereby authorizes and directs the appropriate City Officials to do all things necessary and expedient to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 5. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.
