AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 155, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 155.027, ENTITLED "ZONING MAP," TO RE-ZONE THE APPROXIMATE 1.6-ACRE PARCEL OF LAND GENERALLY LOCATED SOUTH OF PINES BOULEVARD AND WEST OF SW 64TH WAY, LOCATED AT 6460 PINES BOULEVARD, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"; RE-ZONING FROM THE CURRENT ZONING OF B2-A (PLANNED BUSINESS CENTER) TO B-3 (GENERAL BUSINESS), SUBJECT TO THE RECORDATION OF A DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "B"; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested a zoning change from B-2A (Planned Business Center) to B-3 (General Business) for the approximate 1.6-acre parcel, generally located south of Pines Boulevard and west of Southwest 64th Way, located at 6460 Pines Boulevard, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested that the approximate 1.6- acre of the property be rezoned to B-3 in order to allow the Applicant to redevelop the site as a service station, convenience store and accessory automatic car wash; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2019, the Planning and Zoning Board of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida, in accordance with the law held a public hearing for the purpose of making its recommendations regarding a zoning

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change to the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board, at its December 12, 2019 meeting, voted to recommend approval to the City Commission of the rezoning of the Property as requested, subject to the recordation of the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, in receipt of the recommendations of Staff and the Planning & Zoning Board, has held further public hearings, in accordance with the law; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida to approve the re-zoning of the property, subject to the conditions set forth herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida hereby approves the re-zoning of the approximate 1.6-acre parcel of (00349223.1 1956-7601851)

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land generally located south of Pines Boulevard and west of Southwest 64th Way, located at 6460 Pines Boulevard, as more particularly described in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto, from B-2A (Planned Business Center) to B-3 (General Business), subject to the recordation of the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"**, and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Comprehensive Zoning Code of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida. The sections of this Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section", "Article" or other such word or phrase in order to accomplish such intention.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force and effect.

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Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its
