A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, R ENAMING SW 14TH STREET AT SW 184TH AVENUE TO “ENCANTADA BOULEVARD” WITHIN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 100.02 OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES CODE OF ORDINANCES; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO BROWARD COUNTY; DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Encantada at Pembroke Pines Community Association is petitioning the City of Pembroke Pines to change the name of SW 14th Street at SW 184th Avenue to Encantada Boulevard and has submitted a resolution executed by the Board of Directors,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 100.02 of the City's Code of Ordinances, the City Commission finds it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City to rename S.W. 14th Street at S.W. 184th Avenue within the City of Pembroke Pines “Encantada Boulevard,” as a primary street name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Commission, in accordance with Section 100.02 of the

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City's Code of Ordinances, hereby renames S.W. 14th Street at S.W. 184th Avenue within the City of Pembroke Pines "Encantada Boulevard," as a primary street name while retaining SW 14th Street as the secondary name between SW 196th Avenue and SW 184th Avenue.

Section 3. The City Commission hereby authorizes and directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of this resolution to Broward County. The City Commission hereby further authorizes and directs the appropriate city officials to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.

Section 7. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
