A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION (“FUNDING AGREEMENT”); DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE FUNDING AGREEMENT TO THE FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) emergency has caused disruption in Florida’s economy leading to high rates of unemployment and business closures; and

WHEREAS, Many Floridians are in need of assistance with rental payments, mortgage payments and home repairs; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has been awarded funds pursuant to, section 601(d) of the Social Security Act, as amended by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Pub. L. No. 116-136, div. A, Title V (Mar. 27, 2020); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the CARES Act Funds (designated the “Coronavirus Relief Funds or CRF Funds”) will be distributed by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation to and administered by Eligible Local Governments; and

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WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines is considered an Eligible Local Government; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that approving the Funding Agreement is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens and residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby approves the Funding Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. The City Commission hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to transmit the executed Funding Agreement to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation, and further authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documents related to the Funding Agreement.

Section 4. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

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Section 6. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
