AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1932; PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 FOR THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2019, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines adopted Ordinance No. 1932, thereby adopting a budget for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, certain revisions to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget are now necessary based upon the actual amounts received and disbursed through the date of this Ordinance and anticipated through the end of the Audit of the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget, and recommends the adoption of the same by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the proposed budget amendments and finds the adoption thereof to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Pembroke Pines, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby incorporated herein and

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made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Pembroke Pines hereby amends Ordinance No. 1932 to provide for changes in revenues and the corresponding expenditure and appropriation of such funds as provided in the Amended Budget for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 3.</u> The provisions of this ordinance shall not be deemed to be a limitation on the powers granted to the City Commission by the City Charter, which relates to the fiscal management of the City's funds.

<u>Section 4.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> If any clause, section, or other part or application of this ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force or effect.

<u>Section 6.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
