WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Pines ("City") has an agreement with both the Aging and Disability Resource Center of Broward County and Broward County to provide Senior Transportation and fixed route transportation services respectively, and;

WHEREAS, the City utilizes funding from the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") to assist in the operation of its Senior Transportation and fixed route transportation services, and;

WHEREAS, the City, as a sub-recipient of FTA funds, is required to adopt FTA Title VI Program Guidelines (Exhibit "A") every three (3) years;

WHEREAS, the City's 2020-2023 FTA Title VI Program Guidelines, which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A", have been reviewed and approved by the Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that approving the 2020-2023 FTA Title VI Program Guidelines is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens and residents of the City.

Section 5. If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.
