MOTION TO RATIFY THE CITY MANAGER'S APPROVAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE RESCUE MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT FROM THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE (BSO) FOR AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$182,700 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 PER SECTION 35.18(C)(5) OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE WHICH ALLOWS THE UTILIZATION OF OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY CONTRACTS FOR COMMODITIES OR SERVICES.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

- 1. On October 05, 2015, the City Commission authorized the purchase of Fire Rescue Medical Supplies and Equipment from the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) for an estimated amount of \$182,700 for fiscal year 2015-2016 with no charge for administrative fees, markup pricing, or shipping per Section 35.18(C)(5) of the City's Procurement Code which allows the utilization of other governmental agency contracts for Commodities or Services.
- 2. The City of Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue Division has been satisfied with the process and prices that have been established by the BSO in regards to the purchase of medical supplies and equipment that are necessary to the Department's daily operations relating to medical emergencies, accidents, fires, incidents with hazardous materials, etc.
- 3. The Fire Rescue Division would like to continue purchasing all medical supplies and equipment necessary for daily operations from the BSO. For the small number of items that cannot be obtained from BSO, the Fire Department will utilize proper procurement procedures for obtaining the necessary products.
- 4. The ability to purchase from the BSO will allow the City's Fire Rescue Division to take advantage of regional purchasing thereby saving time and money. The utilization of a single source for supplies reduces the number of vendors that the Fire Department has to oversee. In addition, items currently stored in the Broward County Warehouse are obtainable the same day or next day, allowing purchases of appropriate quantities from the County and saving the City delivery costs and the cost to store supplies.
- 5. On October 03, 2016, the Purchasing Manager obtained approval from the City Manager to continue purchasing these items through the BSO as the Fire Department had some supplies that they needed to procure as soon as possible in the 2016-2017 fiscal year.
- 6. Request the City Commission ratify the City Manager's approval for the purchase of Fire Rescue Medical Supplies and Equipment from the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) for an estimated amount of \$182,700 for fiscal year 2016-2017 with no charge for administrative fees, markup pricing, or shipping per Section 35.18(C)(5) of the City's Procurement Code which allows the utilization of other governmental agency contracts for Commodities or Services.
