MOTION TO RATIFY THE CITY MANAGER'S APPROVAL TO UTILIZE DOWNRITE ENGINEERING CORPORATION FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF AN 8-INCH SEWER LINE BREAK ON WASHINGTON STREET AND HIATUS (WOODBIDGE) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$58,500.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

1. On June 6, 2018, an 8-inch sewer line break was damaged by Edison Electric, who was setting poles on behalf of Florida Power & Light.
2. The City will be seeking reimbursement from FPL for this repair.
3. The Utilities Division contacted Downrite Engineering Corporation to repair the 8-inch sewer line break, and received a quote for a total cost of \$58,500.
4. Per Section 35.18(C)(1) of the City's Procurement Code; "In urgent cases of compelling emergency that require the immediate purchase of commodities or services, the City Manager is empowered to waive competitive bidding or competitive proposals and authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to secure by open market procedure any commodities or services, notwithstanding the estimated cost of the commodities or services."
5. Request Commission to ratify the City Manager's approval to utilize Downrite Engineering Corporation for the emergency repair of an 8-inch sewer line break on Washington Street and Hiatus (Woodbridge) in the amount of \$58,500.
