MOTION TO APPROVE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND PEMBROKE PINES POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR OVERTIME INCURRED IN SUPPORT OF SOUTH FLORIDA HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (SFLHIDTA) COCAINE STRATEGY INVESTIGATIONS LED BY U.S. SECRET SERVICE

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

- 1. SFLHIDTA's Cocaine Strategy Initiative has approved reimbursing Pembroke Pines Police Department up to, but not to exceed \$18,343.75 for overtime expenses incurred in Cocaine Strategy investigations led by U.S. Secret Service Electronic Crimes Task Force.
- 2. Monroe County Sheriff's Office will act as a fiduciary for SFLHIDTA
- 3. Funds shall not be used to pay for overtime related to training attendance, on noninvestigative work, or fringe benefits.
- 4. This Memorandum of Understanding has been reviewed and approved to legal form by the Police Legal Advisor.
- 5. Recommend Approval of the agreement.
