MOTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF TEXTBOOKS FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR FROM THE FLORIDA SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$683,641 FOR ALL SEVEN CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES CHARTER SCHOOLS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 35.18(C)(7)(J) OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES.

- Chapter 35 of the City's Code of Ordinances is titled "PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES, PUBLIC FUNDS."
- Section 35.18 of the City's Code of Ordinances is regarding "COMPETITIVE BIDDING OR COMPETITIVE PROPOSALS REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS."
- Section 35.18(C) states that "Only the following situations are exempt from the competitive bid and competitive proposal requirements of this section:"
- Section 35.18(C)(7) states that "The following contractual services are not subject to the competitive procurement requirement:"
- Section 35.18(C)(7)(j) states that "Educational books, technical publications or other type trade journals;"
- Section 35.21(A)(1) states, "An initial purchase of, or contract for, commodities or services, in excess of \$25,000, shall require the approval of the City Commission, regardless of whether the competitive bidding or competitive proposal procedures were followed."

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

- 1. Each year the Charter Schools budget funds for the purchase of new textbooks. Textbook purchases are determined by the adoption of State approved instructional materials for specific classes.
- 2. The Department of Education requires that all instructional materials purchases from the "State-Adopted Instructional Materials Catalog" must be ordered from the Florida School Book Depository (Exhibit 1. FLDOE Instructional Materials Information).
- 3. Recommend City Commission approve the purchase of textbooks for the 2020-2021 school year from the Florida School Book Depository in an amount not to exceed \$683,641 for all seven City of Pembroke Pines Charter Schools, pursuant to Section 35.18(C)(7)(j) of the City's Code of Ordinances.
