MOTION TO APPROVE PROPOSED RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-R-47.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION 2021-R-47 IS A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES APPROVING THE UTILITY WORK AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A" AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR UTILITY WORK ON DYKES ROAD, NW 196TH AVENUE AND NW 10TH STREET AT NW 129TH AVENUE; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE FDOT; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

1. The City of Pembroke Pines (City) supports roadway and utility work including protection, relocation, installation, adjustment or removal of facilities along Dykes Road, NW 196th Avenue, and NW 10th Street, by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

2. During construction of the bicycle lanes on these roadways the FDOT contractor will be modifying and adding drainage, widening and milling and resurfacing and will be impacting certain manholes and valve boxes.

3. The City agrees to have FDOT contractor perform this utility work for an estimated cost of \$43,377.60 as reflected in Exhibit B.
